ETHOS FIREARMS & DEFENSIVE TRAINING REQUESTS YOU TO PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

For valuable consideration and to induce permission to participate in firearm training and operations conducted by Ethos Protection Services, Inc. (DBA - Ethos Firearms & Defensive Training), (hereinafter referred to as "Ethos"), the undersigned(s) agree to the following terms and makes the following warranties:

The Undersigned hereby affirms and acknowledges that I am aware that firearms training and operations have inherent risks which may result in serious injury or death.

I understand that operating firearms with explosive components involves certain inherent risks which may require transport to a medical facility; explosive detonations, misfiring, hang firing, and other malfunctioning of ammunition the firearm or its components; ricocheting of projectiles, or impacted materials which may occur during training. I understand that the activities which are necessary for training and for certification, may be conducted at a site that is remote, either by time or distance or both, from such a medical facility. I still choose to proceed with such instructional activities in spite of the possible absence of a medical facility in proximity to the training site.

I understand and agree that neither Ethos, my instructor(s), Sam Carter, the facility at which I receive my instruction ("the Facility"), nor collectively any of the above entities respective employees, shareholders, officers, agents, contractors, instructors, patrons, participants or assigns, (hereinafter referred to as "Released Parties") may be held liable or responsible in any way for any injury, death, or other damages to myself or my family, heirs, estate, or assigns that may occur as a result of my participation in this firearms class or as a result of the negligence of any party, including the Released Parties, whether passive or active.

In consideration of being allowed to participate in this course, I hereby personally assume all risks of this course, whether foreseen or unforeseen, that may befall me while I am a participant in this course, including but not limited to the academics, travel or practical firing activities.

I hereby RELEASE and agree to INDEMNIFY, DEFEND AND HOLD HARMLESS the Released Parties from and against any liability, demand, claim or right of action for any damage or injury, including paralysis or death, to any person or property, even if such damage or personal injury results from the NEGLIGENCE of the Released Parties or any other parties. I further COVENANT NOT TO SUE or make any demand or claim against Ethos or other parties released in accordance with this agreement, for or by reasons of any such damage or personal injury from my participation in the subject firearm training and operations. I agree to pay all fees, damages, and costs, including attorney's fees and court cost Ethos or any Released Party may incur in the enforcement of this agreement.

I also understand that shooting and participating in live fire exercises are physically strenuous activities and that I will be exerting myself during this firearms training course, and that if I am injured as a result of a heart attack, panic, hyperventilation, or any other cause, that I expressly assume the risk of said injuries and that I will indemnify, defend and hold harmless the Released Parties responsible for the same.

I further state that I am of lawful age and legally competent to sign this liability release, or that I have acquired the written consent of my parent or guardian. If I am a parent or guardian of any minor person under 18 years of age participating in these firearm training and operations given by the Released Parties, I make these representations and agree to the terms of the Assumption of Risk, Release, Covenant Not to Sue and Indemnification and Defend Agreement contained herein on behalf of each minor, as well as myself, and I agree to assume responsibility for their safety. I further agree to INDEMNIFY, DEFEND and HOLD HARMLESS the Released Parties, from an against any demand, claim, right of action or suit that may be brought on behalf of any such minor arising from the firearm training and operations. I will pay all fees, damages and costs, including attorney's fees and court costs, the Released Parties may incur in the enforcement of this agreement.

I understand the terms herein are contractual and not a mere recital and that I have signed this document of my own free act and with the knowledge that I hereby agree to waive my legal rights. I further agree if any provision of this Agreement is found to be unenforceable or invalid, that provision shall be severed from this Agreement. The remainder of this Agreement will then be construed as though the unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.

I have read and understand the Ethos Firearms & Defense Training Concealed Carry Weapons Course Syllabus, ("Syllabus") in its entirety and further understand it is my sole responsibility to apply this information whenever I carry a concealed weapon. The Undersigned hereby understands the Released Parties attempt to keep the Syllabus updated and accurate but the Undersigned Participant has full responsibility to research and understand California and Federal law independent of the Syllabus supplied as part of this course regarding concealed carry weapons and agrees to research, understand and comply with those laws.

I HAVE FULLY INFORMED MYSELF OF THE CONTENTS OF THIS LIABILITY RELEASE AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK AGREEMENT BY READING IT BEFORE SIGNING IT ON BEHALF OF MYSELF AND MY HEIRS. I FURTHER REPRESENT THAT I HAVE BEEN GIVEN THE OPPORTUNITY TO HAVE MY ATTORNEY REVIEW THIS DOCUMENT AND HAVE DONE SO BEFORE SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT OR HAVE WAIVED MY RIGHT TO DO SO.

Notice of Restricted Persons

ETHOS FIREARMS & DEFENSIVE TRAINING REQUESTS YOU TO PLEASE READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING

The California Department of Justice Bureau of Firearms says that state and federal law make it unlawful for certain persons to own and/or possess firearms. I understand that persons meeting any of the following conditions are prohibited.

- Any person who is convicted of a felony, or any offense enumerated in Penal Code sections 29900 or 29905
- Any person who is ordered to not possess firearms as a condition of probation or other court order listed in Penal Code section 29815, subdivisions (a) and (b)
- Any person who is convicted of a misdemeanor listed in Penal Code section 29805 (refer to List of Prohibiting Misdemeanors)
- Any person who is adjudged a ward of the juvenile court because he or she committed an offense listed in Welfare and Institutions Code section 707(b), an offense described in Penal Code section 1203.073(b), or any offense enumerated in Penal Code section 29805
- Any person who is subject to a temporary restraining order or an injunction issued pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure sections 527.6 or 527.8, a protective order as defined in Family Code section 6218, a protective order issued pursuant to Penal Code sections 136.2 or 646.91, or a protective order issued pursuant to Welfare and Institutions Code section 15657.03
- Any person who is found by a court to be a danger to himself, herself, or others because of a mental illness
- Any person who is found by a court to be mentally incompetent to stand trial
- Any person who is found by a court to be not guilty by reason of insanity
- Any person who is adjudicated to be a mentally disordered sex offender
- Any person who is placed on a conservatorship because he or she is gravely disabled as a result of a mental disorder, or an impairment by chronic alcoholism
- Any person who communicates a threat to a licensed psychotherapist against a reasonably identifiable victim, that has been reported by the psychotherapist to law enforcement
- Any person who is taken into custody as a danger to self or others under Welfare and Institutions Code section 5150, assessed under Welfare and Institutions Code section 5151, and admitted to a mental health facility under Welfare and Institutions Code sections 5151, 5152, or certified under Welfare and Institutions Code sections 5250, 5260, and 5270.15
- Any person who is addicted to the use of narcotics (state and federal)
- Any person who is under indictment for information in any court for a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year (federal)
- Any person who has been discharged from the military under dishonorable conditions (federal)
- Any person who is an illegal alien (federal)
- Any person who has renounced his or her US Citizenship (federal)
- Any person who is a fugitive from justice (federal)

THE UNDERSIGNED UNDERSTANDS AND AGREES THEY ARE ENTIRELY RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLYING WITH ALL FEDERAL, STATE AND LOCAL LAWS AND REGULATIONS RELATED TO THE OWNERSHIP, POSSESSION, USE, SALE OR PURCHASE OF ANY FIREARMS OR WEAPONS AND THEY BEAR THE ENTIRE RESPONSIBILITY FOR ASSURING THEY ARE IN COMPLIANCE WITH ALL THE ABOVE REFERENCED LAWS OR ANY OTHERS REGULATING FIREARMS. THE UNDERSIGNED FURTHER HAS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY TO RESEARCH AND UNDERSTAND THOSE LAWS THAT MAY AFFECT THEIR POSSESSION, OWNERSHIP, USE, SALE OR PURCHASE OF A FIREARM. UNDERSIGNED HEREBY DOES CERTIFY THAT THEY ARE NOT A PERSON PROHIBITED UNDER FEDERAL, STATE OR LOCAL LAW FROM POSSESSING A FIREARM, AND NONE OF THE ABOVE CONDITIONS APPLY TO UNDERSIGNED.
